Members: Make Sure You Renew



If you receive one of the postcards above from your health plan, your NJ FamilyCare renewal mail is coming this month.

Make sure NJ FamilyCare/Medicaid has your correct mailing address

Members can confirm or update their contact information by calling NJ FamilyCare at 1-800-701-0710 (TTY:711). NJ FamilyCare will use this information to communicate with members about their healthcare coverage.

Respond to mail for NJ FamilyCare/Medicaid

Members need to look for and respond to mail from the State of New Jersey or Mercer County Board of Social Services. If NJ FamilyCare requests information, they need to respond right away to avoid a gap in their NJ FamilyCare coverage.

Get help completing your renewal if you need assistance

Members can get help or ask questions about their renewal by calling the NJ FamilyCare health benefits coordinator at 1-800-701-0710 (TTY:711) or by reaching out to Mercer County Board of Social Services (609) 414-7053. There are several community organizations that have participated in NJ FamilyCare training and are available to support members with their renewal. Members can contact any organization for assistance, even if it is not in their county. SNAP Navigator Program

Need Help with Your Application? Ask a SNAP Navigator

Applying for SNAP/Food Stamps can be confusing. A SNAP Navigator can help you apply and help you keep your benefits, so you can get the food assistance you need. SNAP Navigators will walk you through:

- How SNAP works
- Eligibility requirements
- What documents you need to apply
- The application process
- How to keep your SNAP benefits

They also can answer questions and correct misconceptions about SNAP to help you decide if SNAP is right for you. This help is free and confidential.

Find Help in Mercer County

SNAP Navigators often hold events in your community at food pantries, senior centers, health care facilities, libraries, schools and other locations. Be aware that there are other agencies that might claim to be "SNAP consultants," asking for your personal information to complete a pre-approved SNAP application or telling you that an application was initiated on your behalf.

If you think a letter or text is a scam, do not reply at all. If you do not know if a request for personal information is real, contact Mercer County Board of Service Services. You should never be asked to pay for help with filling out an application. There is no charge.
