ANNOUNCING BIG SAVINGS FOR ELIGIBLE NJ SENIORS

Dear New Jersey Resident Age 65+

We are pleased to announce that Governor Murphy's Fiscal Year 2022 Budget has raised the annual income limits of two state-funded prescription drug benefit programs by \$10,000.

- Pharmaceutical Assistance for the Aged and Disabled (PAAD)
 - o Pay \$5 or \$7 for covered prescriptions
 - o The program may also pay your Medicare Part D monthly premium
 - o For residents age 65+ with incomes up to \$38,769 if single, \$45,270 if married*
 - Senior Gold Prescription Drug Discount Program
 - o Cut your prescriptions costs in half after a \$15 co-pay
 - For residents age 65+ with incomes up to \$48,769 if single, \$55,270 if married*
